Lady Falcons rally to clinch first-round bye

EL CAMPO — Foster clinched the District 24-4A first-round bye with a tense victory over El Campo at Lady Bird Field.

The Lady Falcons (8-0 in district) scored the game-winning run in the seventh when Dana David doubled off the top of the fence and scored on Jamie Moreno's double.

Keely Shuler retired the Lady Birds in the bottom of the seventh to close out the win. She allowed just three hits and struck out five.

Foster got two hits apiece from Moreno, Emily Bledsoe and Kathleen Zellers, scoring solo runs in the fifth, sixth and seventh innings after the game went scoreless for the first four.

"These girls are confident in their ability to come out and play either at home or on the road," said Foster coach Christie Rees. "We got into trouble in the sixth, allowing two runs on two errors, but came back

to finish strong in the seventh. They really play as a team and stand behind each other."
